## Oral statement submitted by IIMA – Istituto Internazionale Maria Ausiliatrice And co-signed by VIDES International – International Volunteerism Organization for Women, Education and Development

IIMA and VIDES International commend the constructive participation of South Sudan in its third UPR.

We welcome the acceptance of all recommendations aiming to promote the right to education for all children in South Sudan<sup>1</sup>.

We note with concern that children do not have equal access to education, especially girls and children from the rural and remote areas, where access to quality education is particularly limited. The inadequate teacher training is also a matter of concern.

Moreover, despite the fact that the Constitution and the Child Act provide for free primary education, in practice parents are asked to contribute to teachers' salaries. This results in children from low-income family to drop out school, since their families cannot assume this additional cost.

Therefore, IIMA and VIDES call on South Sudan to proceed with immediate and effective implementation of UPR recommendations, especially in regard to the right to education.
