Thank you, Mister President.

VIDES and IIMA welcome Congo's acceptance of several UPR recommendations regarding the right to education, and specifically recommendation No. 128.146 to reform the educational system in order to guarantee free compulsory education for all boys and girls, without any distinction. ¹

However, we note with concern that, especially in the rural and most marginalized areas, children belonging to low-income families are denied access to education due to the persistence of indirect school charges.

With regard to the quality of education, the pupil-teacher ratio remains high and the teachers sent to rural areas receive little support or guidance from the government.

In line with the UPR recommendations, VIDES and IIMA call on Congo to:

- Increase the budget allocations for adequate educational materials and infrastructure in order to achieve effective free education.
- Ensure quality education for all children, in particular by providing adequate training and support to teachers in rural and remote areas.
